INFORMATION SHEET FOR VISITORS GUESTS, VISITORS AND MEMBERS

Pike Hills Golf Club wants its members, guests and visitors to enjoy our course and facilities in a warm and friendly manner.

As with all Golf courses we do of course have some basic rules that we would like everyone to understand and abide by.

To avoid any unnecessary embarrassment or conflict we have outlined below our dress code, both for on the course or in the clubhouse.

If you do not conform to the dress code you will be asked to change into appropriate clothing.

Our club shop has a wide range of appropriate clothing should you require it.

These are our required standards:

ON THE COURSE

What we would like to see

- All shirts must be tucked into trousers or shorts except ladies' shirts which are designed and shaped to be worn outside.
- Gentlemen must have shirts with collars and sleeves. Polo neck or turtle neck shirts may be worn.
- Golf shoes must be worn.
- Ladies shirts can be collarless and may be sleeveless, V-Neck 's allowed.
- Headwear must be worn in the appropriate way. E.G. Peaks facing forward)
- All shorts must be tailored and knee length and worn with either knee length or ankle length sports or trainer socks.
- Ladies may wear calf length trousers and trainer socks.

Guidelines acceptable dress for Ladies

Ladies shirts can be collarless and maybe sleeveless, V-neck's allowed

Headwear must be worn in the appropriate way. E.G. Peaks facing forward)

All shorts must be tailored and worn with either knee length sports or trainer socks

Guidelines for Unacceptable Dress for Ladies

IN THE DINING ROOM FOR FORMAL OCCASIONS Smart Casual dress (including smart denim jeans with no rips or tears) is permitted in the restaurant at all times unless deemed otherwise.

THE DRIVING RANGE – Casual dress is allowed on the driving range and putting area

IN THE CLUBHOUSE AND SURROUNDING AREAS

- Any of the above is appropriate except golf shoes may not be worn in the clubhouse.
- Gentlemen must wear socks at all times.
- Golfing head wear, waterproofs or wet golf attire must not be worn in the clubhouse.
- Smart casual wear including smart denim jeans (with no rips or tears) is acceptable
- Smart clean trainers can be worn in the clubhouse.
