Lady Champion Trophy

Best gross score over 36 holes (stroke play)

Hazel Cushing Trophy

Best nett score over 36 holes (stroke play)

A player cannot win both the Lady Champion Trophy and the Hazel Cushing Trophy. If the same player has the best gross and nett scores, the gross score takes precedence for the Lady Champion Trophy, and the Hazel Cushing Trophy will be awarded to the next best nett score.

Hopefully this will eliminate the confusion which has occurred over the past two years.
