Lady Captain's Report

This month is slightly longer report as we fast approach the end of the main golfing season. Last month was fair weather for the golfers. For the Ladies committee, it was mainly about the controversial consideration of increased numbers of qualifying score cards imposed by England Golf from 6 to 10 cards. On the 23rd September the second (final) competition against the Lady Vice captain v. Lady Captain's team was held. The first match was tied in April, and it relied on this final match to get a winning score. The Lady Captain's team won outright 7-2 and were awarded the Dorothy Lecker Shield. In the last weeks of September the final three mixed matches were played - the joint Rabbits and Bunnies Greensome teams, the Ladies v. TOFFS

match, on the prestigious Triangular match. There were a record number of entrants, played in continuing good weather. Moving into October the Triangular match between Pike Hills, Fulford, and the York was held at Pike Hills. Traditionally, this is included husbands and wives playing on the team, but as we lost some couples, we have had a number of new people moving into those slots, which is excellent progress. The York held onto the trophy for yet another year but not for want of some very good competition. The ensuing meal, prepared by chef Paul, was very friendly, with lots of new friends made in the process. The visitors were all very complimentary of the excellent condition of the course, which we were lucky to play in dry weather yet again.

By the 14th October, we had moved into Winter Games season, with British Summer Time ending, the hour dropped back, moving us from 10 minutes slots down to 7 minutes slots on BRS, as usual. It has been very rewarding to see a large number of the ladies new to golf transferring across and joining in with the winter games. It has been an excellent opportunity to pair experienced players with those new to golf, giving the latter the opportunity to learn more about course etiquette; where to place their bags and how to score. The numbers for the Tuesday games continue to be high which is very pleasing, although we have now reduced to 9 holes due to the expected onset of inclement weather. The Club ended the season with the traditional Captains' Big Bash (and big spend on the entertainment!). It was a highly successful evening with 'bowl food' and where the music of the Bee Gees was showcased. Over £220 was raised for the joint Captains' charities - Admiral Nurses (part of Dementia UK) and York Against Cancer. It was a very relaxed evening with everyone up and dancing, filling a packed floor, which has to be an indication of how enjoyable people felt it was, and well worth the big spend.
