Lady Captain's expenses were discussed and it was agreed to increase the amount this year to £520 and set this for the next 5 years.

Handicap Secretary's Report

The cost of this year's competitions was discussed and following information given by the Club's Handicap Secretary it was agreed to raise the entry fee to £4 for 18 holes and £3 for 9 holes. The 2's would be an additional cost of 50p. This will generate £1 to the ladies section, £1 to the Club and £2 for prize money. The Handicap Secretary had done some workings out that there could be a potential £1000 going to the club if 20 or more people regularly compete. As we have not had formal notice in writing from the club regarding this change the Secretary was tasked with contacting Darren Meek to obtain this for our records.

All competitions for the year are now on the How Did I do app.

It was also noted that there may be someone willing to help with the Handicap Secretary's role and more information will be given when this has been confirmed.

Any Other Business

An email was read out from Hazel Cushing informing us that Jean Green would like to purchase prints for the new part of the ladies locker room. The frames will be the same colour as the ones we always have. The Committee discussed that we need to ascertain the size and style of the pictures and the possibility of having unframed prints like in the Dining Room instead of lots of blue frames. Once we have this information we can discuss further.

Exchange Day at Ripon was discussed, Lady Vice Captain informed us that they had initially only blocked out a 1 hour slot, this has now been changed to 11 am to 1 pm. It was also advised that we are in discussions with the coach company regarding the pick up at Pike Hills on the day, as it depends on the day whether or not it can come down the ramp or collect on the A64 lay-by. Ian Craig Health & Safety agreed to speak to them on this point.

March 9th - YLGCA event at Pike Hills is all organised, car park attendants are in place and ladies to help on the day.

March 26th - East Yorkshire Ladies Winter Golf AGM, Lady Captain to welcome ladies on the day.
