New Ladies to Golf Report

LNTG Stage 1 commenced on 22 April with 24 ladies a+ending. Stage 2 (Improvers) will commence on 3rd June. So far 23 ladies who a+ended Stage 1 have indicated that they will a+end Stage 2. A Pike Hills Beginners handbook will be issued to all ladies a+ending Stage 2.

Women in Golf Report

Vicki Joughin and I had a meeting recently with Lucinda Rigg who has recently started a new role at England golf as the Women's Growth Officer for the north. Her role is to support a new initiative to increase women's membership at golf clubs across the country. This work will look at women's membership and specifically those under the age of 50, as of the 12% of current female members at golf clubs across the country, only 2% make up this category. As part of this project, Lucinda was visiting a few clubs to understand the golfer's pathway from beginner to Golf Club member. She was very keen to work with us at Pike Hills. A further meeting with Lucinda is now scheduled for Monday 1st June.

Item Discussed

Hazel Cushing attended to ask for our opinions on the photos which Jean Green has expressed interest in funding for our ladies locker room. We discussed our preferences and Hazel said she would prepare a few images and send to us for approval.

Sandy Kelly (Vice Captain) attended to ask for our help on St Leonards Hospice Day. We have been asked as usual to provide volunteers for the half way house and also provide baked goods and raffle prizes. We will produce a sign up sheet for the locker room in plenty of time and assured him that

on the day we will do everything he needs us to do. The half way house will need manning from 10.00 to 5.30.

Lady Vice informed us that Pontefract have now come back to us and reported that our exchange day cannot go ahead next year due to Tuesdays being Mens competition day. She has contacted a number of other clubs and is awaiting a response.

Any Other Business

We had a note in the suggestions book re number of cards etc for qualifying competitions. We discussed as a committee and sent the following response:-

Thank you for taking the time to share your comments in the suggestion book. They were discussed at the Ladies' Committee meeting yesterday 19 May 2026.

In response to your queries:

- 9-hole cards are not considered equivalent to 18-hole rounds and therefore do not count towards the required six qualifying cards.
- Some cup and trophy competitions may count towards the six qualifying scores. The eligibility criteria for each competition have been displayed on the Ladies' locker room notice board (within the competition section) since January, and are also outlined on individual competition notices and in the "What's Happening This Month" updates.
- Supplementary rounds do contribute towards your handicap, but they do not count towards the six qualifying scores.

That said, this reflects the current position. Mel has been in touch with Darren Meek, as she is aware of recent changes to the men's competition entry requirements, including the introduction of divisions within qualifying competitions. She is keen to review this and explore alignment between sections to ensure consistency across Pike Hills Golf Club.
